Terrell led a life of drug abuse and gang membership. He tells of how he was a drug dealer and involved inner city youth in this activity, many of who 'followed in his footsteps'. After years of drug abuse and drug dealing, his ties with his family were severed. He didn't understand the tough love they were giving him and soon found himself with no help and no place to go. Terrell was now homeless.

Terrell spent two weeks sleeping in his car. One day, while he was walking the streets, his 23-year-old niece saw him, told him he needed help, and invited him to stay with her. It was during that time that he recognized his selfishness and what his actions had done to his family – and he made the choice to seek help.

Terrell knew in his heart that what he needed was God. He wasn't finding it in the places where he sought help for detox and recovery,



but a couple of counselors knew about Wayside Cross Ministries and recommended he consider heading west to Aurora. He found his way to the Master's Touch program where at first, he was resistant, but after his 30-day 'probationary' period, he signed the required paperwork and committed to complete the program.

Today, Terrell is a transformed man, fully aware that he has a new life thanks to the redemptive power of Jesus Christ. Terrell has been attending school, working toward completing his GED. When asked what he wants for his future, Terrell answers: "I want to give back. I don't want these kids who have looked up to me in my past life to continue down the same path as I did. I don't live on that path anymore; I live in the way of the Lord. That's where I want these kids to live, too."

Terrell gives all the glory to Jesus Christ, and is grateful for his time at Wayside Cross Ministries and for those who have helped him through this journey.
