RESIDENT'S DAILY ROUTINE

LIFESPRING PROVIDES A SIX MONTH TO ONE-YEAR BIBLE-BASED DISCIPLESHIP PROGRAM FOCUSED ON INSTRUCTING WOMEN ON HOW TO RESTRUCTURE THEIR LIVES ACCORDING TO THE WORD OF GOD AND SUPPLYING THEM WITH THE BEST TOOLS TO LIVE A RENEWED LIFE.

At Lifespring, the women and children are not required to leave during the day and they are given support and guidance through our staff and volunteers.

The daily routine of the women here includes:

Breakfast at 8:00 AM

Devotions after breakfast

Classes and Groups most days from 10 AM – 2 PM. These include: Monday- Self Confrontation Lessons Tuesday- Independent Study Wednesday- How to Study Your Bible Thursday- Biblical Healing, Book Club Friday- Bible Study

Dinner at 5:00 PM

In the evenings we often have volunteers come in and do activities with the ladies or many of our residents will use the time to engage in Independent Bible Study.

Monday and Friday evenings, Lifespring staff lead a Biblically based relapse prevention group focusing not only on substance abuse but on all forms of idolatry.

On top of the class instruction and Bible study, Lifespring provides case managers to work with each resident weekly to help navigate the different goals and areas of growth the women are working on. Those goals include: medical, social, educational, and employment, as well as working on securing long term housing.

In addition to case management, all of our residents participate in weekly Biblical counseling sessions to address the underlying issues of the heart.

The women also have access to several mature Christian women from the community that come in to mentor and sometimes just lend a listening ear to our residents.

It is our hope, through all that we do, that the women will be equipped to live a life that brings glory to God.

Family Dinners



Each evening, our women and children gather for a meal that has been prepared by another resident in the program. This time is an important opportunity for our women to fellowship with one another and to reflect on the day. These meals look much like dinner at any family's home. There are negotiations over dessert between the moms and their kids, there are spills, and at one point a back up peanut butter and jelly sandwich is brought in when someone doesn't like what has been prepared.

EVERYDAY TASKS SERVE AS JOYFUL REMINDERS

With Lifespring currently housing 18 adults and 10 children, the number of loads of laundry is high. Residents are grateful for use of the newly donated washing machine as it helps make washing clothes more timely and efficient.
