Once again, Mark Elfstrand, host of "Let's Talk" (AM 1160, Hope For Your Life), will serve as Master of Ceremonies.



Dr. Stetzer is also Executive Editor of Facts & Trends Magazine, a Christian leadership magazine with a circulation of 70,000 readers.
