

UYM uses play money called CHAMPS (Christian Homework and Mentoring Programs) dollars to reward kids for good behavior. The kids, in turn, get to spend the money at the CHAMPS store that offers candy, toys, clothing, school supplies, etc., for purchase. The kids are required to save one dollar in order to create a saving habit; they also learn to save up money for larger purchases. The middle/high school program on Thursdays takes it one step further, they receive CHAMPS dollars for good grades as well as good behavior and, at Christmas time, instead of using the dollars to purchase items for themselves, they use the money to purchase Christmas gifts for their families. The kids are able to wrap the gifts they purchased, to take home and put under their family's Christmas tree!


