RECOVERY VS. MADE NEW



SEPTEMBER IS NATIONAL RECOVERY MONTH. THOUGH AT LIFEPSRING WE ARE KEENLY AWARE THAT MANY OF OUR RESIDENTS STRUGGLE WITH ADDICTION CONCERNS, IT IS OUR HOPE THAT OUR WOMEN WOULD NOT SIMPLY RECOVER THEIR FORMER SELVES, BUT WOULD HOWEVER BECOME A NEW CREATION.

At Lifespring it is not unusual that the women seeking shelter here are wrestling with some type of addiction. This is especially true because not all of our new residents have a negative urinalysis screening upon entrance. Potential residents can enter our program as *Safe in Place* if they are still testing positive for illicit substances upon admittance. This is determined on a case by case basis.

At Lifespring, we do not shy away from working with the women to address their addiction concerns. We desire for all the women who come through our doors to break free from sinful patterns, addictions, and all forms of idolatry, but not so that they can simply regain or recover broken relationships, financial stability, health, etc.

It is our desire that the women would surrender their lives to Christ and that they would subsequently walk as a new creation. And though regaining those things listed above will naturally begin to occur for those who are living a surrendered life, helping the women grow in Truth will always be our first priority.

We have full confidence in the redeeming power of the Gospel. As such, we continually stress the importance of being equipped with truth so that the Holy Spirit can enable them to exercise self-control and to battle the desires of the flesh.

As a mandatory part of the curriculum, our women participate in a biblically based relapse prevention group every Monday and Friday evening that focuses not only on chemical addiction, but on all forms of idolatry.

In addition to the relapse prevention programming provided to the women in house, our residents also have the

opportunity to concurrently participate in outpatient substance abuse treatment with one of our local partnering treatment providers (Breaking Free, Inc. and Gateway Foundation) as part of our *Safe in Place* program. There is also the option to work intensively with our trained staff independently for those desiring not to seek outside treatment.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

For various reasons, some women are not able to complete our one year Redeemed for His Work program; whether it is due to finally being accepted into housing or whether there is a limitation preventing them from being successful.

For some that means that they will go their own way, and we as a staff team trust in God to continue to be doing a work in their lives. However, as of more recently, some of those women have been able to take part in one of our newer programs that allow them to come and participate in the various classes offered during the day even though they are no longer a resident.

This allows these women to remain in a healthy community and to benefit from the biblical teaching that occurs in all of the classes here. This opportunity allows these women to continue to be built up and in turn allows our residents to continue to glean from them and be mutually encouraged.
