The New Life Corrections Ministry's Annual Friendship Dinner, its annual fundraiser, is being held at Gaslite Manor, 2485 Church Road in Aurora, on Friday evening, November 2nd. Doors open at 6:00 pm, and dinner will be served at 6:30 pm.

Our guest speaker will be Chaplain George Adamson, Senior Chaplain at Stateville Prison in Joliet. George has been chaplain at Stateville for over 20 years, overseeing more than 3,000 inmates and 2,000 volunteers, 67 religions, and 200 programs. He also serves as Master Chaplain and Chairman of the Religious Advisory Board at the IDOC, and pastors the Storehouse of Prayer Church in Aurora. He and his wife, JoAnne, have been married 40 years. They have four children, nine grandchildren, and four granddogs.
