When a part-time weekend position became available I was excited to join the work being done at Lifespring, and now that I have come on full-time, that excitement has only continued to grow. I love to get to witness God at work in these women's lives, and to help the women here wrestle with the Truth.

I have confidence that God can do a work in their lives and am grateful that I can take part in speaking the Truth into their lives.


Marquerite Blitch, Senior Case Manager Lifespring Ministry

Meet Janet Hershey

Janet came to faith six years ago and through her hunger for the Lord's word, almost immediately knew she needed to find a place where she could share her faith and help those in need. In the midst of praying for God to show her a place where she could serve, she became aware of Lifespring when she found out a friend from her past was a resident. Janet did some research, prayed, and knew God had a plan for her at Lifespring. Since becoming a volunteer, Janet has hosted Bible studies, scheduled play dates with the kids of Lifespring (to give the moms a break), and currently does one on one mentoring. Janet, along with her husband Craig, also spend ten months a year working with a team of other volunteers and staff to plan and host the annual Lifespring fundraiser.

Here is what Janet has to say about her time at Lifespring and what it means to her:

- Volunteering at Lifespring has been rewarding and heartbreaking, but mostly I feel contentment when I think about my time serving there.
- Rewarding because I have a past of struggling with addiction, divorce, teenage parenthood, and other struggles that, by the grace of God, I have overcome. It is rewarding to be able to share my story and allow God to use it to help others.
- Heartbreaking when women come into Lifespring and aren't YET ready to make a change in their lives and leave before completing the program.

Contentment because even when someone leaves early, I know that God's will shall be done in their lives. I know that no matter how much I may want to "save" these women, they are God's to save and all I can do is trust in God! I have faith God will use their experiences at Lifespring to help guide them to His ultimate plan for their lives. Contentment because so many women DO complete the program and God allows us to be part of that transformation!! GOD IS GOOD!
