NO CHILD CHOOSES TO BE HOMELESS. THEY ARE VICTIMS OF CIRCUMSTANCE. IF YOU LOOK BACK, YOU'LL SEE THAT THEIR PARENTS FELL PREY TO THE SAME TRAPS THAT THEIR PARENTS AND GRANDPARENTS DID.

Lifespring Ministry houses an average of 32 children every year. As we help our moms get their children prepared for the school year, we are reminded of the impact homelessness has on our littlest residents.

The reality is that exposure to trauma as a child predicts adult homelessness as accurately as any other measure.

That means that kids who grew up abused, surrounded by drugs, in extreme poverty, or on the streets are more likely to end up following that same pattern.

Unless that pattern is broken.

At Lifespring Ministry, we don't only

house and feed people. We help those who come here overcome addiction and other strongholds in their lives. We teach the life skills that they need, but may have never learned before.

We all want to change our community. We all want to change the future and end homelessness, and the truth is, that starts with healing families and rescuing children. Breaking the cycle of homelessness while sharing the love of Christ is the best recipe we know for making the most significant difference.

Your support helps us to work with each woman and child who comes through these doors. Each mom, while they are here, participate in Bible classes,

learning how to study their Bible. In addition to their classes, they have job readiness preparation, and they have opportunities to learn skills for independent living as they help with meal planning and complete household chores.

Our moms also have the opportunity to receive parent coaching to help them better meet their children's needs.

Learn About Our Jumpstart Program



For our residents who have successfully graduated from Lifespring, and for varied circumstances find themselves needing to return, there is a program that has been implemented to help them get back on track.

We desire to be a resource to program graduates as they make the transition to independent living, but we know there will be periods where they may need to return for a period of time.

Lifespring Ministry's Jumpstart program is a six-month program meant to get the women back into the word and to reaffirm biblical principles they may have lost sight of when they left Lifespring.

Women who enter this program are expected to find full-time work within the first 30 days of returning, and they are immediately plugged back into Bible study, meeting with a biblical counselor, and receiving case management.

Summer of SERVICE

Lifespring Ministry is truly a blessed community. What makes us so fortunate? People like you. During this time of year we reflect and give thanks to God for all we have been given.
