4. What are some opportunities you see for others to volunteer at Lifespring?

"Childcare is so needed to allow the Mom's to participate in events, practical instructions on budgeting and home management. Professional parenting counseling. Seminars on personality types. Healthy food preparation. Prayer partners."

Dana:

1. Why do you volunteer at lifespring?

"A few years ago, I found out about Lifespring at an annual dinner that my church hosted benefiting Lifespring. Seated at my table was a Lifespring graduate whose testimony made me want to help other women the way she had been helped. I longed to be a part of an organization that could help women in all aspects of their lives - spiritually, emotionally, physically. When my schedule freed up a couple of years later, I was able to begin volunteering on a regular basis, and I've loved every minute of it."

2. What do you do at Lifespring when you are here?

"In the beginning, I mentored ladies one-on-one. I eventually began to help with marketing, including with the annual fundraising event. I continue to help with marketing and also volunteer once a week with my therapy dog, Duke. The hour we spend with the ladies each week is the highlight of mine and Duke's week!"

3. How do you relieve stress?

"To relieve stress, I love playing team sports like tennis and basketball because they allow me to exercise and be with my friends at the same time. I also love all kinds of puzzles because putting things where they belong helps me feel centered and organized. As you can imagine, my house is very tidy because I get stressed when things aren't where they should be. (Everything has a place and should be in its place, right?!)"

4. What are some opportunities you see for others to volunteer at Lifespring?

"There are so many areas to volunteer at Lifespring like preparing a meal, mentoring, fundraising, teaching a class, or hosting a craft night. I have many friends who are looking for a way to make an impact in the world around them. I ask them to visit Lifespring by taking a tour or helping with a game night and then praying to see if God is calling them there. It's not for everyone. It can be challenging, heart-breaking, and discouraging. But showing Christ's love to others, especially at a time when they are hurting and fragile, can make such a huge impact on someone's life. It's been a hard realization that I know Lifespring is not their savior. Our savior is Jesus, and we are just His hands and feet, planting seeds and taking care of His people who are in need."
