


From Transformation to Transformers, WCM Enters a Relationship with a Local Manufacturer...

The collaboration with Micron started small. Three men from Wayside, Michael O'Kier (Wayside's Outsourcing Manager), Raulon Robinson and Darin Severson began working on this project, tasked with completing the wiring of the transformers. All three men work in one work station but expansion will occur in the future, to



include three work stations and six men in all.

Of course, there was training involved in order for the men to learn how to do the job. They were trained by Dan O'Brian, Senior Manufacturing Engineer, and Jerry Atosch, Quality Control Manager. The men were taught

the critical steps to complete the transformers in a "light" assembly line atmosphere, from start to finish, including how to package the product to send to Micron's quality control department located in Sterling, Illinois before they are shipped to the customer.

This is the first step in this venture, but it is a big one for these men, who expressed their excitement about this new experience as it not only increases their employability but, in their words, "it gives us self-worth."

Robinson woke up that first morning of training and happened to throw on a t-shirt that he picked up at WCM's thrift store that said, "Power to Transform," "Heal, Inspire, Innovate, Connect, Lift, Enable, Share." The perfect shirt, he felt, for what is *transforming* here.

I have moved out of Wayside, have a full time job, and am living in the Wayside Manor apartments. My health is better and my soul and heart are doing very well. There is never a day that goes by where I don't thank God

for saving me and for the people He brought into my life.

On and off over the years, I struggled with brokenness, caused by drugs and alcohol. I just could not forget the memories of things that happened to me as a kid growing up in the projects on the South side of Chicago. All of this brought me to Wayside.

Coming to Wayside has changed my life so much. By God's grace and through the teaching and lessons I learned here, I came to Christ. I am more humble

than I have ever been in my entire life.

I am currently a Resident Assistant, working with other residents as they enter the program, helping them with whatever they need as they go through the program, and become a better person, in life and society.
