


JOIN US ON NOVEMBER 9^{TH} FOR OUR FRIENDSHIP DINNER

CHAPLAIN LEON McCLIMANS

Chaplain Leon McClimans is serving at Sheridan Prison. He's been serving there the last four years. As a strong Christian Leader he's brought much change into Sheridan Prison. In the last 30 months he's gotten Compass Church messages streamed into this prison. On Saturdays inmates listen to the sermon and get into small groups. New Life Corrections started a class at Sheridan in July. *Freedom From Fear* is taught every Thursday by Chaplain Steve Madawick. Many men are paroling to Wayside's Masters Touch program. Leon is a former clinical counselor and Hospital Hospice Chaplain. He and his wife Krista have 3 children and 7 grandchildren. Sheridan has over 60 men graduated from our Freedom From Fear class.

WHERE DONATIONS GO

- Every year NLC reaches over 3,000 inmates across 40 Illinois prisons with our two-day DADS and Freedom From Fear seminars.
- 24 visits are made to the Statesville NRC, reaching over 3,400 inmates with the gospel.
- We provide the incarcerated with materials, Bibles, and Bible studies that invite them to come to Jesus.
- We connect inmates on parole to the Master's Touch men's program and the Lifespring women's program upon their release.
- We have class at Kane County and Mchenry County Jails, and reach out to over 1000 inmates with our materials at these jails.
