





Jeremy Hits Restart After a Lifetime of Addiction



Like most youngsters, Jeremy looked up to his older brother and wanted nothing more than to follow in his footsteps. "If he'd played football, I would have been a football player," he says. However, Jeremy's brother drank. Consequently, by the time Jeremy finished high school, he was drinking and using marijuana every day.

For the next few decades, Jeremy lost every job he had because of his addiction. He went through at least 30 rehabs, treatment programs, and other facilities. He overdosed multiple times. Last year, after Jeremy was kicked out of a sober house, a friend told him, "I found a place for you. It's not the Taj Mahal, but it will change your life." That was Wayside Cross Ministries.

When Jeremy started the Master's Touch program, he sat in the back row, gradually moving up as other residents graduated and left. Soon, he found himself sitting in the front row, absorbing everything he heard. Although he had never attended church growing up, he read his Bible constantly, going deep into the Word.

Jeremy helped out in the warehouse, then at the front security desk. After a few months, he was hired as a Resident Coordinator, screening new residents, helping them with their applications, and making them feel welcome. "By the time they go up to bed for the first time, they feel like they've already got a friend," he says.

Now sober for more than a year, Jeremy says, "It's a miracle. I've been offered this chance to hit restart on my life the way God wants me to live it, and I feel a divine obligation to be more like Jesus."

After burning countless bridges in his life, Jeremy has restored his relationship with his family — including his older brother. "He's doing okay now," Jeremy tells us. "He's blown away by how good God has been to me. He tells me, 'I'm proud of you.' But I say, 'Don't be proud of me. Give the glory to God.""

While giving glory to God, Jeremy gives thanks to you. "Without you, there would be 88 homeless men on the street right now. Your donations definitely transform lives, and we love you."
